PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE RELATIVE TO CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF) TO FUND SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT CONSISTING OF AN EXTENSION OF AN EXISTING SANITARY SEWER INTERCEPTOR

Notice is hereby given that the Genesee County Drain commissioner – Division of Water and Waste Services (GCDC-WWS) will hold Public Meeting on the proposed sanitary sewer collection system improvements for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

GCDC-WWS is seeking CWSRF financing to construct an approximate 12.5-mile sanitary sewer interceptor extension. The extension would include installation of a new sanitary sewer, beginning at a location near the intersection of Court Street and Irish Road, in Davison Township and extending south into Oakland County, primarily adjacent to Irish Road and Vassar Road. The extension would convey sanitary waste north, ultimately to the Anthony Ragnone Wastewater Treatment Plant, located in Montrose. The project would also include installation of 1.4 miles of sewer along Dixie Highway/Saginaw Road in Grand Blanc Township to serve the proposed Technology Village (as Phase II) as well as 4.3 miles of sewer along Oak Road and Lippincott Boulevard in Davison Township (as Phase III).

The project would reduce loading on the existing sanitary waste collection infrastructure in Grand Blanc Township, which currently operates at or near capacity during wet weather. Sanitary sewers servicing communities along the proposed alignment, including Atlas Township and Davison Township, would also


be connected to the proposed extension. Additionally, the extension into Oakland County would allow for additional sanitary sewer construction (proposed by Oakland County communities) to service communities in northern Oakland County that have historically utilized primarily on-site septic systems for sanitary waste disposal. Installation of municipal sanitary sewers in those areas is anticipated to improve surface water quality both locally and in downstream areas located in Genesee County.

Construction cost are estimated at approximately \$42,100,000 and would primarily be funded by fees assessed to users in Grand Blanc Township, potential users in northern Oakland County, and an American Rescue Plan Act award; however, a relatively small rate increase is also anticipated for other communities in Genesee County.

Copies of a Project Plan, detailing the proposed project, is available for inspection during normal business hours at the GCDC-WWS office (located at 4610 Beecher Road, Flint) and at the Grand Blanc Township Hall. Written comments may be provided prior to the meeting and should be clearly labeled as “CWSRF – Public Hearing to Fund Sanitary Sewer Collection System Improvements” and sent to:
